Budget was reviewed by Board and some changes were made. During salary discussions for Town Clerk Bryn Flagg and Wendy Flagg recused themselves and left room During Highway Superintendent salary discussions Carol Hall recused herself and left room. Recreation Commission representatives, Michelle Lawrence and Judith Whitney, addressed Board discussing 2023 summer recreation program. The enrollment had doubled from last year, kids' activities included programs through the Henderson Watersports program, library program and Henderson Harbor Preforming Arts. All were enjoyed by all. A request for more funding was made due to minimum wage increases and the ability to retain the current staff members, transportation cost for bussing and expand with a couple extra trips for next year. Board requested ratio of Town of Henderson kids vs. Town of Ellisburg kids. Board agrees to allow extra funding request for recreation summer program. Discussions on water districts and the risk of low reserve funds available in case of an emergency. Board agrees to move forward with preliminary budget. Budget director is waiting on a couple numbers from County, but Budget can be adjusted in time to adopt in November.

# ORDER OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HENDERSON PURSUANT TO NY TOWN LAW §209-D SEWER DISTRICT NO. 1 AMENDMENT/EXTENSION

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Henderson, held at the Town offices located at 12105 Town Barn Road, Henderson, NY on September 26, 2023 there were:

WHEREAS, this Board is considering whether it would be in the best interest of residents of the Town of Henderson, and who own property along the east side of NYS Route 3, and several additional properties adjacent to the current boundaries of the Town of Henderson Sewer District No. 1 (consisting of 374 potential hook-ups to a public sewer system), to amend/extend the Town of Henderson Sewer District No. 1 (additional potential 39 hook-ups to a public sewer system) to serve such persons and property (413 total potential hook-ups to a public sewer system), and

WHERAS, private septic systems along the east side of NYS Route 3 and several parcels adjacent to the current boundaries of the Town of Henderson Sewer District No.1 have failed and/or will potentially fail and this scenario has intensified due to seasonal flooding along Lake Ontario; and

**WHEREAS**, the possibility and/or probability of seasonal flooding along Lake Ontario cannot be predicted with absolute certainty, but the risk appears to be higher due to many factors; and

**WHEREAS**, the ongoing risk(s) will likely cause continued problems/failures of private septic stems and increase danger(s) to the health, safety and welfare of the public, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board intends to protect its citizens, the public and the environment, and

WHEREAS, due to the small size of parcels and poor drainage of soils on those parcels, and the risks summarized above, the Town engineer has prepared a certain Map, Plan and Report for the purposes of amendment/extension of Sewer District No. 1 within the Town of Henderson, reciting the boundaries of the proposed District amendment/extension and the nature and type of infrastructure needed for the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, a detailed explanation of how the estimated cost of hook-up fees, if any, and the cost of the district as amended/extended to a typical property was computed may be found in the Map Plan and Report, and

**WHEREAS**, the Map, Plan and Report are filed with the Town Clerk of the Town of Henderson.

**NOW**, on motion duly made and seconded, it is

**FOUND, ORDERED AND DETERMINED** that the above recitations are included herein and incorporated by reference, and it is

**FOUND, ORDERED AND DETERMINED** that the Map, Plan and Report prepared for the Town for the purpose of proposed amendment/extension of Sewer District No. 1 has been duly filed with the office of the Town Clerk as required by law, and is available thereat for public inspection, and it is

**FOUND, ORDERED AND DETERMINED** that the boundaries of the proposed Sewer District No. 1 amendment/extension shall be as appear in the Map filed with the Town Clerk and as described on the attached Schedule "A", and it is

**ORDERED**, that the estimated cost to a typical parcel (hook-up) annually is anticipated to be at, or below \$693.00 per E.D.U., the maximum amount to be spent for the district as amended/extended is \$28,000,000.00 and the estimated costs for hookup fees, if any, are \$0.00 per E.D.U.; and it is

**ORDERED**, that a public hearing be held on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of October 2023 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Offices located at 12105 Town Barn Road, Henderson, New York to hear all person(s) interested, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Town Clerk shall cause a copy of this Order to be published at least once in the official newspaper for the Town of Henderson not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days before the date set for the hearing, and shall cause a copy hereof to be posted on the sign board of the Town of Henderson maintained pursuant to the provision of the Town Law, not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days before the date designated for the hearing and shall cause a copy to be uploaded on the Town of Henderson website.
