§ 90-1. Enactment.

The State of New York, in Article 18 of the Executive Law, has enacted the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code Act, to be effective January 1, 1984.

§ 90-2. Option of declining administration or enforcement.

Under § 381, Subdivision 2, of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code Act, local governments have the option of declining to administer or enforce the Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code.

§ 90-3. Determination not to administer or enforce.

Pursuant to the aforesaid § 381, Subdivision 2, of the Executive Law of the State of New York, the Town of Henderson does determine that it will not administer or enforce the New York State Fire Prevention and Building Code promulgated by the State Fire Prevention and Building Code Council pursuant to §§ 377 and 378 of the Executive Law of the State of New York.
