Motion to accept July Supervisor’s report as presented by Supervisor Glaser.

Town Board members were provided with a copy of the monthly revenues and appropriations report.

Jerry Tackley reviewed the financial report for the Rhode Center and thanked the Town for the yearly contribution. With the level of local donations and State & Federal funds from the pandemic the Center is in very good shape, busier than ever but financially sound.

Town assessor, Mary Cornell , was hoping to begin the revaluation process starting March of 2022 but with limited help available from the County and other Town’s having a higher priority than Henderson she found it best to hold off. Our Town equalization rate is holding at 98.5% which is down slightly but still considered very good.

Tom Deuson presented the Town Board with petitions from over 100 concerned citizens from Snowshoe Road about the speed of traffic along the road. Due to the volume of

traffic, the increasing size of campers, ATV's, golf carts, bicycles most of which are operated by youngsters and the people walking. The narrow and winding sections of road and cars parked along the edge of the road it has become a hazard to even try to pull out of a driveway. The lowering of the speed limit from the intersection of Military Road and Snowshoe Road to the end of Snowshoe Road at "the Cut" from 30MPH to 25MPH would significantly slow traffic and possibly place more warning signs to allow for more reaction time to a possible incident.

REDUCTION OF SPEED LIMIT ON SNOWSHOE RD.

On a motion by Councilwoman Parker-Lane, second by Councilman Flagg the following motion was

Resolves to authorize Town Clerk to submit the request to reduce the speed limit from 30 MPH to 25MPH from the Military Road and Snowshoe Road intersection to the end of Snowshoe Road /"The Cut" to New York State Department of Transportation and Jefferson County Highway Department for their review. This would include the entire length of Snowshoe Rd. to be reduced to 25MPH.

Dwight Davidson represented the Henderson Business Community Council informing Board of a representative from Clayton who could speak with the Board and answer questions about Local Development Corporations if they would like to learn more about them. Possibly put a 48'x24' promotional sign on properties privately owned on an existing building in the Harbor to be the same as billboards. Board would have to review request with several different entities.

Solar moratorium to expire on August 13th send County Planning Board's comments to Solar review group and have them review for feedback. Supervisor will get with Town attorney for what next steps would be to move forward.

Possibly the Town and owners of Association Island may want to do signage together and support the speed reduction on Snowshoe.

Lee Cagwin – Does the Town have any jurisdiction over the parking in the Harbor especially on the busy weekends?
